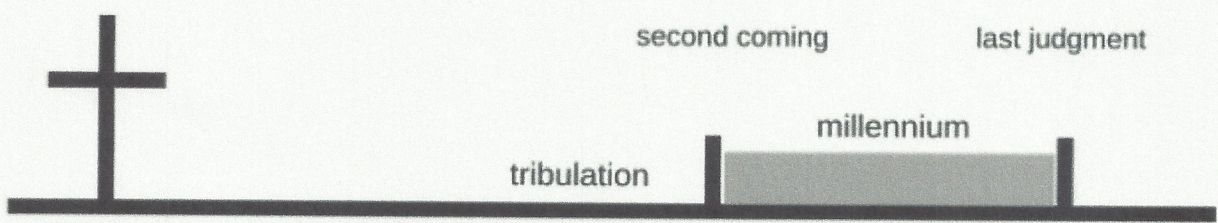
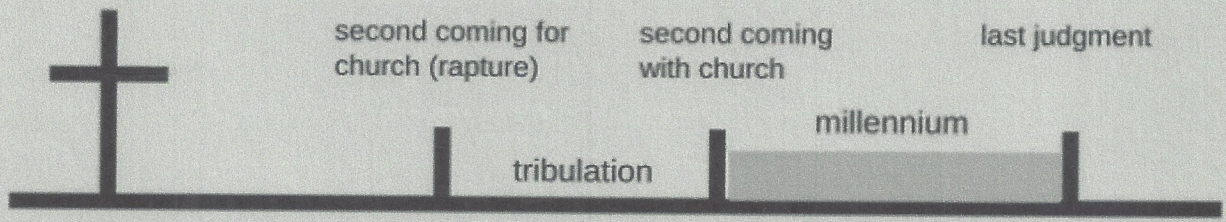

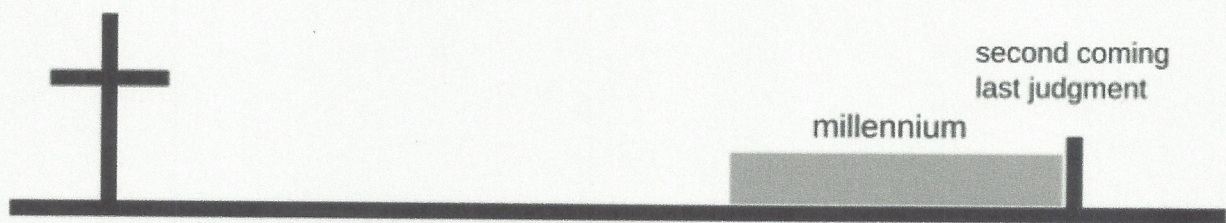
1. *Post-tribulational Premillennialism*



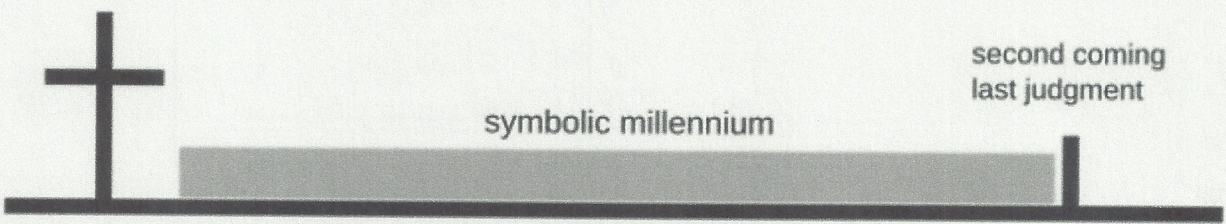
2. *Pre-tribulational (dispensational) Premillennialism*

## DISPENSATIONS OF TIME

1



### Innocence

- First man and woman pure and innocent.
- Enjoyed fellowship with God.
- Made stewards of God's earth.
- Disobedience resulted in sin and death—with promise of a coming Savior.

### Conscience

- Blood sacrifices "covered" man's sin.
- Conscience guided man's moral acts.
- By calling upon the name of the Lord and offering blood sacrifices, fellowship was restored.

### Human Government

- Authority for men to begin governing others.
- Capital punishment instituted.
- At Tower of Babel, men forced to scatter to replenish earth.

### Promise
